SUPPLEMENT

1. It is reported that there has been a split in the Ecuadorian Socialist Party because of a disagreement over policy and the Party program. Carlos Palacios Saenz of Guayaquil, together with several outstanding members, has withdrawn from the Party. This group plans to form an organization known as the Partido Nacionalista Socialista. They feel that owing to a lack of political wisdom among Socialist Party leaders in Quito, the opportunity of getting into the driver's seat was lost by not supporting Carlos Manchano in his revolutionary coup.
2. The following is reported to be the platform of the new Party:
 - a. Establishment of enterprises and projects under national operation without competing with private capital.
 - b. Establishment of a parliamentary form of government to replace the present congressional type.
 - c. Development of cooperatives.
