1. A branch of the Partito Nazionale Italiano (PNI) is reported to have been established in Genoa, with headquarters at Via Lanfrancani 5. The Genoa section has 2,000 members, almost all former members of the Fascist armed forces, members of the Squadre d'Azione Mussoliniane (SAM) groups, disident members of the Uomo Qualunque (UQ) and former members of the Armata Italiana di Liberazione (AIL). The PNI has within its ranks many war criminals and persons who participated in the mopping-up operations of the Black brigades. The directors of the movement themselves admit that they have many undesirable elements in their ranks.
2. The aim of this party is to create political strife, to sabotage labor organizations, and to provoke incidents among the various political parties.
3. Steri, the organizing secretary of the Genoa group, has allegedly been waiting for the authorization from Milan to create new branches of the party in Bari, Naples and Rome, a matter which has been under consideration for some time. However, the Central Direction of the PNI, fearing reprisals from the left-wing parties, has not yet acted.
4. The officials of the Genoa PNI are:

- (a) Davide Sega - Political secretary. Former editor-in-chief of a Fascist paper.
- (b) Sabatini - In charge of organizing PNI groups. An electrical technician.
- (c) Mario Sega - Son of Davide. Administrator.
- (d) Sirigu - In charge of propoganda. Former war correspondent of the paper Repubblica Fascista.
- (e) Steri - Vice organizational secretary. A former member of the Fascist divisions Arditi, and former Guardia Giurata (Country Police).
