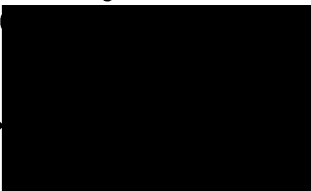

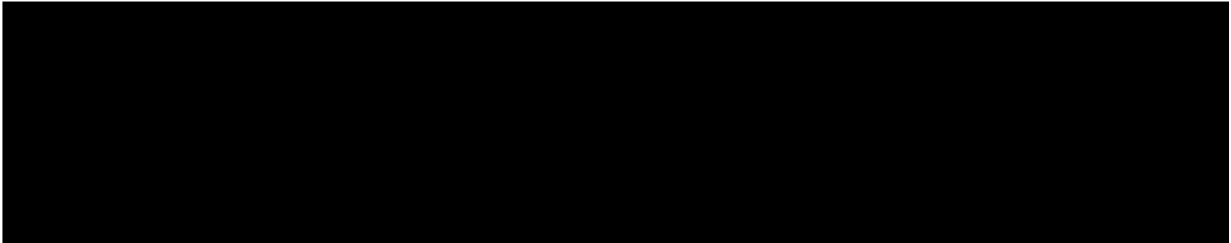

C-3 1. Major Alejandro Soria, Argentine Military Attache to Ecuador, is reported to be in frequent contact with Colonel Carlos Mancheno, leader of the August coup in Ecuador. Mancheno allegedly has stated that Soria is endeavoring to arrange an appointment for him in Argentina and that President Peron is personally interested in his going there. The purpose of this proposed visit was not ascertained.

B-3 2. It was further stated that Soria was called back to Argentina rather suddenly, but his return to Ecuador is expected shortly.

The above is reported as a matter of possible interest in the event that the two reports may be related. It should also be recalled that during Mancheno's dictatorship he was preparing for close cooperation with Argentina.
