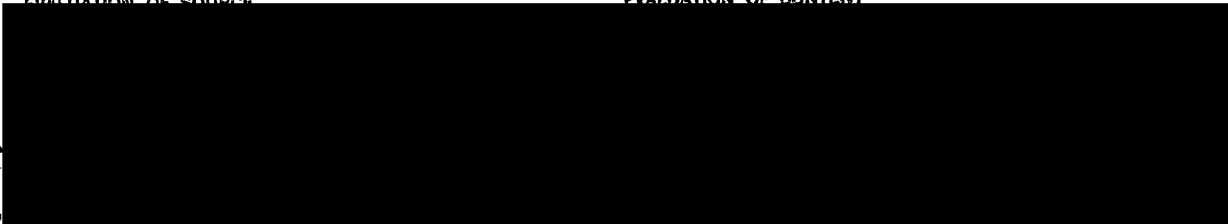

EVALUATION OF CONTENT



1. It is reported [REDACTED] that an important conference was to be held in Guatemala beginning 5 November by Nicaraguan Liberals and Conservatives to discuss means for removing General Somoza from the Nicaraguan political scene. The meeting was to be presided over by President Arevalo of Guatemala, with the support of President Castaneda of El Salvador. It was hoped to persuade Somoza to withdraw by guaranteeing his person and property.
2. Those attending the meeting were said to include General Emiliano Chamorro, (fnu) Arguello Bolanos, Gustavo Manzanares, and Toribio Tijerino (Conservatives); and Ramon Gonzalez, Rosendo Arguello, and the latter's son (Liberals).
