Questioned on his attitude towards Kaiser, he was told to attend the CDU executive committee meeting and to make a speech condemning Kaiser's policy, simultaneously announcing that he has lost confidence in Kaiser. The draft of the speech was given to him. Drastic measures were threatened if he refused. After his release from headquarters Wolf went to a member of the CDU Vorstand for advice. As a friend of Kaiser he did not want to oppose him, but he has parents, wife, and four children living in the Russian Zone.
