- b. Tac HQ - has the same composition as that of an infantry division, with less personnel. One section of the operative HQ is composed of members of the various departments which is partly motorized and armored and follows the actions of the armored and motorized brigades.
- c. Tank Brigade - HQ six officers, 30 NCOs and EM, five tanks, three armored cars, five trucks.
- d. Two Battalions: A battalion has three companies, each company has six tanks. There are 21 tanks, of which three are at battalion HQ (one recovery tank), 11 officers, 110 EM.
- e. One Motorized Battalion: Two normal companies: One support company with four 82mm mortars and two heavy MGs. Total 15 officers, 300 EM.
- f. One Anti-Tank Battery: four 76mm or 45 mm horse-drawn anti-tank guns, four officers, 60 EM.
- g. Engineers Company: Road engineers platoon. Bridging platoon. Minelaying and minelifting platoon. Five officers, 120 EM.
- h. Signals Platoon: One wireless truck. Telephone teams with each infantry battalion.
- i. Anti-Tank Rifle Section: Three platoons, each with three 14mm A Tk rifles three officers, 35 EM.
- j. Transport Unit: 15 vehicles, workshops truck, recovery truck, water truck.
- k. Total of Tank Brigade: 47 medium or heavy tanks, three armored cars, 35 vehicles, four A Tk guns and nine A Tk rifles, four 82mm mortars, 62 officers, 850 EM.
- l. A Tk Artillery Brigade: HQ. One group of German armored A Tk 75mm guns, one group of Russian 76mm A tk guns; one group of German 88mm A Tk guns.
- m. Reserve Tank Battalion: Two companies with a total of 12 tanks.
- n. Engineers Battalion: Three companies with the brigades and some lesser units under division HQ.
- o. Reconnaissance Company: Three platoons, each with two Allied or German half-tracked vehicles.
- p. Medical Battalion: Two companies and a medical section.
- q. Total strength of an Armored Division:

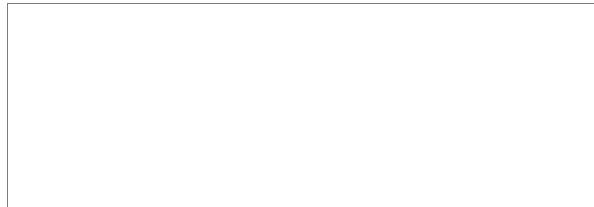
