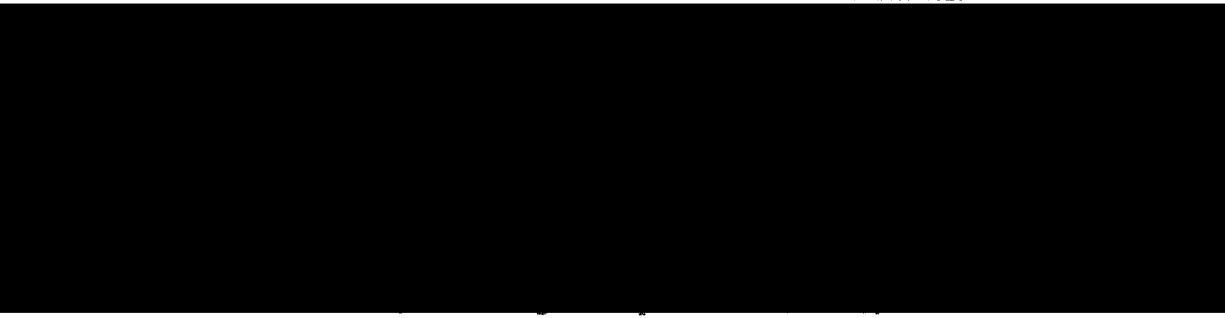

1. The directive council of the Confederacion General del Trabajo (CGT) is currently studying the possibility of organizing a large Latin American labor conference to be held in Buenos Aires on 15 August 1948.
2. The conference, if it is actually held, is expected to be principally political inasmuch as the two major aims would be to extol nationalist sentiments in the various Latin American delegations and to denounce economic imperialism.
3. The planning board anticipates that at this conference President Peron will be declared the leader of social justice and national sovereignty in Latin America.
