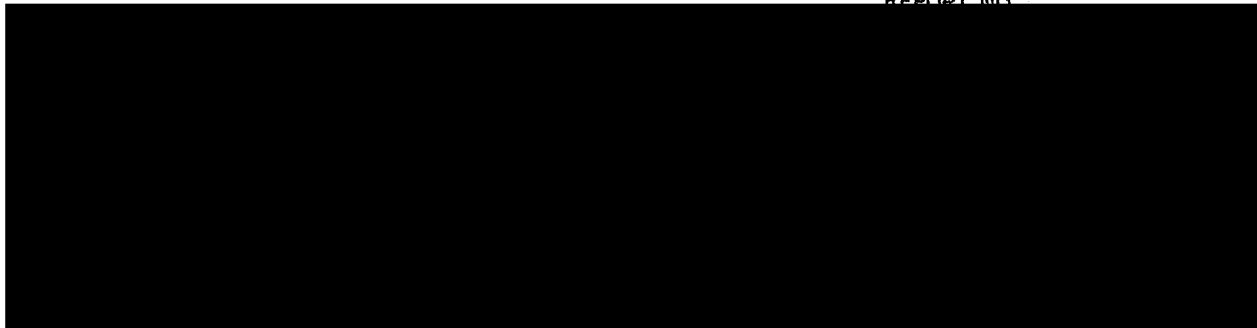

SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.



1. The Ikhwan al-Muslimin (Moslem Brotherhood) is not strong in the Sudan. As a religious organization it is completely overshadowed by the Khatnis of Sayyid 'Ali Mirghani. However, the Ikhwan, which is conducting a campaign against the Christian missions in the Sudan, has been suspected by the Secretary of the Sudan Interior Mission, of stealing letters mailed from the Mission's field outposts to the Khartoum headquarters.
2. Galal al-Din Sanhuri is the Ikhwan organizer for the Sudan. He is under the influence of 'Abd-al-Rahman Mahdi Pasha and the Ummah Party, and as such, is bent on making trouble in Egypt. The last time he was in Khartoum, in December 1947, he was instrumental in inspiring organized aid for the Arab cause in Palestine. At that time the Ummah Party gave a tea-party in his honor at the Grand Hotel, at which many notables, political personalities and government officials were present. The Ashiqqah Party was not invited. Sanhuri made a speech urging the audience to form a committee to aid the Palestine Arabs. The Sudanese subsequently formed the Sudan Central Committee for Palestine Aid.
