- The only significant recent movement on the part of the Syrian Army was the dispatch of the Sixth Infantry Battalion to Mishmar Hay Yarden, Palestine.
- A new unit, named "Selahadin Ayyubi Battalion", is being organized in Damascus, and is to be made up of Palestinian refugees.
- 3. The following confidential official figures of Syrian Army casualties was obtained through contacts at the military hospital:
 - a. Before the Palestinian truce period there were 133 soldiers killed and 451 wounded;
 - b. After the truce there have been 99 killed and 137 wounded. Sixty percent of these casualties resulted from mine field explosions and the rest resulted from mortar fire.
