1. [redacted] between 23 and 28 June 1948, six trains departed from MEdling with Soviet families; more are expected to leave.
2. The trains left via the Sopron and Hegyeshalom routes.
3. [redacted] Soviet civilians are now being withdrawn from Burgenland and north of the Danube. 50X1-HUM
4. There is no sign as yet of large scale de-requisitioning of accommodations, or of the withdrawal of troops.
