1. Radar installations along the Yugoslav Adriatic coast exist at Susak, Split and Boka Kotorska.
2. Fixed stations inland have been built at Ljubljana, Zagreb, Belgrade, Skoplje and Novi Sad.
3. Yugoslavia also possesses a number of mobile radar stations. In early May 1948, there were at Mostar, Divulje, Nis and Ecko (i Ecka).
