SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.

1. The National Program, consisting of twelve articles, has been approved by the following political parties:

- Partai Komunis Indonesia Merah (Red Indonesian Communist Party)
- Partai Boeroe Merdoka (Independent Labor Party)
- Partai Rakjat Djelata (Kidnappers, murderers and looters)
- Angkatan Moeda Komunis - AKOMA (Indonesian Communist Youth Corps)
- Persatwaan Serikat Islam Indonesia
- Badan Kongres Pemuda Repoebliek Indonesia (Congress Body of Youths of Indonesian Republic)
- Gerakan Indonesia Raya (Great Indonesian Movement)
- Partai Wanita Rakjat (People's Women Party)
- Partai Boeroe Indonesia (Indonesian Labor Party)
- Partai Komunis Indonesia - PKI (Indonesian Communist Party)
- Partai Kristen Indonesia - PARKRINDO (Indonesian Christian Party)
- Permai (A new political party of extremists)
- Partai Rakjat (People's Party)
- Partai Nasional Indonesia (National Indonesian Party)
- Barisan Pemberontak Repoebliek Indonesia (Armed "Indonesian Republic Rebel Corps" of Soetomo)
- Masjoemi
- Partai Keamanan Repoebliek Indonesia (Indonesian Security Party, with armed force)
- Partai Sosialis Indonesia of Amir Sjarifoedin

2. Article 1 of the National Program on minorities was made by AKOMA, Partai Boeroe Merdeka, Partai Rakjat Djelata, and Partai Wanita Rakjat. Article 9 on the limitation of the inflow of foreign capital was made by AKOMA, Partai Boeroe Merdeka, Partai Rakjat Djelata, Partai Wanita Rakjat, Permai and P.K.I. Merah.

3. At a meeting held at the palace of President Soekarno on the 14th of July, Article 9 was discussed and it was decided to attach the following clause to this article: "The law will be made to limit the inflow of foreign capital, so that the rule of Article 33 and Article 27 (sub-section b) can be taken." [REDACTED] Comment. It is not clear to what document this clause refers.)

4. After the above noted meeting, Hamoenan and Maroeto Hitimihardjo handed the twelve articles of the National Program to Hatta.
