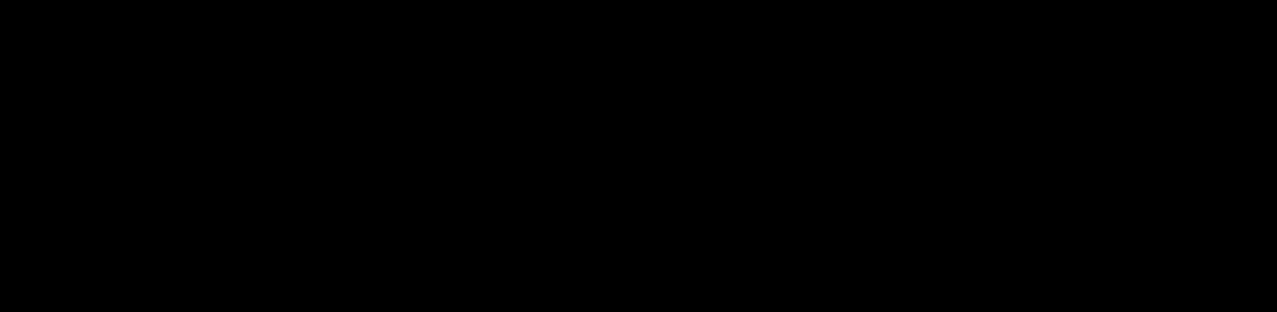

1. The leader of the Partai Komunis Indonesia (PKI) at Bondowoso, Java, has recently gone to Tanggoel for the purpose of setting up a resistance group.
2. An unusually large quantity of weapons is momentarily buried in the highlands in the vicinity of Oedjoeng Koelon (Southwest Bantam). These weapons have come from the Communist Party of India. Illegal weapons are imported via Chilamaya.
