1. Approximately 3,000 Soviet troops left the Döllersheim training area in the middle of June 1948 and proceeded to Hungary by way of Bratislava. Three thousand troops arrived in the Sollenau (X-35) area from Hungary during the middle of June, and 5,000 were expected in Wiener Neustadt. Two hundred and fifty men arrived at Hirtenberg, near Baden, from Romania.
2. There were 7,000 troops at Siget, Romania, early in June 1948. They may have been in transit to some other point.
3. Russian families continued to depart from Austria during June 1948. From the general picture, it would appear that only uniformed women without children may remain in the country.
