The Soviet Industrial Delegation left Yugoslavia for Odessa on 18 July 1948 from the Soviet Military Aeronautical Zone of Sombor (sic). This delegation was stationed at Zagreb, Belgrade and Ljubljana, and was composed of Soviet experts from the Ilyich laboratories at Mariupol, the Institute of Scientific Research, the Ministry for the Construction of Soviet Agricultural Machinery, and Pensa laboratories (RSFSR), the Ryazan laboratories (Russian Central Zone) (sic), the Agricultural Science Academy "Timiriasev", the utensil factory "Avoarmatura", the Rostov laboratories, and the National Rubber Products Factory Laboratory.
