1. The Miass File Factory (Miasski Napilochny Zavod) is located in Miass, Chelyabinsk Province. It is under the control of the Chief Directorate of the Tool Industry of the Ministry for Machine Tool Manufacture, USSR. There are two other factories in the USSR which produce exclusively files of various kinds: one at Serpukhov and the other at Veroshilovgrad.
2. The Miass factory produces files of various kinds: bastard (drachovy), milling (trezerny), smooth (lichny), special, and other files. In 1947, actual output was about eight million files of various kinds, including about 1,200,000 reconditioned (reout) files. As regards quantity of output, bastard files hold first place, followed by smooth files, milling files, and special files in that order.
3. In early July 1948, the director of the Miass factory was Vokhmintsev. Over one thousand workers were estimated to be employed in the factory.
