The trouble which broke out on 13 September 1948 between the Gerakan Revolcesi Rakjat and the Partai Komunis Indonesia (PKI) began sarly in September when 25X1A Dr. Moewardi returned home from Jogjakarta. Dr. Moewardi returned home from Jogjakarta. Comment. Moewardi has since been reported killed in the Madicen incident.) Moewardi conferred with leaders of the Pesindo and the PKI but was not satisfied. The secret meetings were known to the Kommando Keamanan Kota (KKK) (a Republican security unit), which told the resident commissioner of Soerakarta and later the central security police at Jogjakarta.
 - On 13 September 1948, the headquarters of the Pesindo was raided while a secret meeting was being held. A number of newly elected PKI councillors and seven Tentera Nasional Indonesia senior officers were arrested. These arrests occurred after six hours of continuous fighting. Indonesian newspapers stated at first that there were six killed but later revised this figure to fourteen.
