The following is a key to the attached chart of the CPN (Communist Party Netherlands):

The Party Congress which is convoked at least once every two years is nominally the highest authority of the CPN and is responsible for:

- 1. The <u>Central Committee</u> (Partij Bestuur) sometimes translated as Party Executive. This committee, chosen at and by the Party Congress is the actual governing body of the CPN.
- 2. The Executive Committee. Elected by the Political Bureau and responsible for every-day activities and operations of the CPN.
- 3. Party Bureau or Secretariat. All matters affecting the Central Committee and the Executive Committee are first referred to the Party Secretariat which assumes much of the routine work.
- 4. Political Bureau. Receives international instructions and adapts them for internal use.
- Organizational Bureau. Way be considered a section of the Political Bureau which regulates organizational activities of the Party.
- Scientific Bureau. Consists of commissions which study subjects assigned by the Central Committee.

- 20a. "Algemeene Nederlandsche Jeugd Vereenijung" (Netherlands General Youth Movement). The organ of the ANJV is "Len" (One). The workers Youth Movement (Verbond van Werkersjeurd) organizes members up to 16 years of age.
- 20b. OPSJ (Organization of Progressive High School Students) affiliated with ANJV. An organization of students (ULO and MO) (sic) mostly members of the ANJV. Its organ is "De Foort" (The Gateway).
- 21. Radio Verkend Nederland (Radio Vorking Netherlands or Leborers' Broadcast for the Netherlands.) Founded to furnish GPN with broadcast time and facilities.
  - 21a. Tourist Department
  - 21b. Advisory Committee for Cultural affairs. Organ "Vrij" (Free).
- 22. <u>Union of Socialist Choir and Ausical Sovieties</u>. Lends support to Party meetings.
- 23. Free Spain. Anti-Franco Spaniards in The Netherlands. Organ "Vrij Spanje" (Free Spain).

#### 24. Vomen

- 24a. Nederlandse Vrouwen Beweging (Metherlands Women's Movement). The NVB is becoming more communist dominated.
  Organ, "Vrede en Opbouw" (Peace and Reconstruction).
- 25. <u>Association of Former Spanish Civil War Combattants</u>. Purpose is to regain Dutch citizenship for those who fought on the Republican side during the Spanish Civil War.
- 26. <u>Verenizing Nederland-Indonesia</u> (Netherlands-Indonesia Society).

  A pro-Republican organization following the Moscow line in the Putch-Indonesian dispute. Organ, "Indonesia Bulletin".
- 27. <u>Netherlands-USSR</u>. Seeks members from intellectual circles. This organization receives 3,000 guidlers monthly from the Soviet Embassy in The Rague.
- 28. "Perhimpoenan Indonesia", a Communist organization of Indonesians living in the Netherlands. Organ "Varta Indonesia".
- 29. Netherlands-Poland Society. Organ "Nederland-Polen".
- 30. Trade Unions
  - 30a. Einheids Vak Central (Unity Trade Union). The LVC is an independent union but is strongly influenced by the CPN.
    Organ "Norkend Nederland" (Vorking Netherlands).
- 31. <u>Instructors</u>. Divided into the 17 districts listed on the chart. These districts were formed on 1 May 1948 from 381 sections or divisions.
