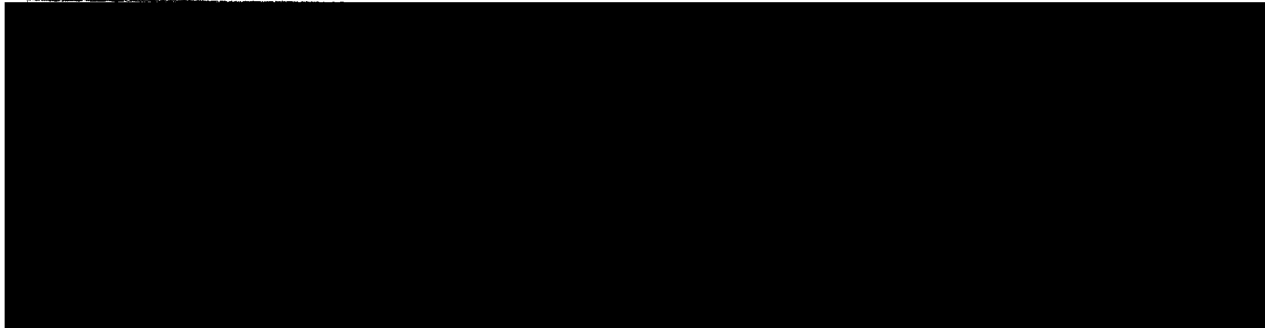

1. Major Ramawi, who is stationed at headquarters in Fort de Kock, has taken a house in Singapore and apparently is planning to stay there for a time. Towards the end of August 1948, he sent two men to Bangkok to take charge of weapons which had been purchased there. The weapons were sent by a Siamese plane to Fort de Kock. Major Ramawi is at present (22 September) getting more weapons.

25X1A6a 2. The Biro Perdjoengan in Pakanbaroe, Sumatra, has sent a man to Singapore to purchase \$250,000 (Straits) worth of weapons. He has gone on to Bangkok. [REDACTED] Comment. The Biro Perdjoengan is probably the same as the Boero Perdjoengan. [REDACTED] reported that Richard Effendi, third deputy chairman of the Malayan Communist Party in Singapore, had come secretly to Batavia and was working with the guerrillas of the Boero Perdjoengan.
