- 1. Witold Skoratowicz, the Warsaw Polish Consul in Damascus, has definitely left that city, and probably will resume his post as Secretary in Cairo. Comment. Skoratowicz was Secretary in the Warsaw Polish Legation in Cairo before being assigned to Damascus in May 1948.) Jerzy Gutkowski, Vice-Consul of the Warsaw Polish Consulate General in Tel-Aviv, is to take Skoratowicz's place in Damascus.
- 2. Jerzy Gutkowski told informant that Skoratowicz's return to Cairo was demanded by Zygmunt Kuligowski, the Warsaw Polish Minister in Cairo. Gutkowski stated that he was to take Skoratowicz's place, but did not know if he would be assigned permanently to Damascus or not.
