

- The Russians are much dissatisfied with the mining methods at Jachymov and 1. are sonding Prof. Bogomoltsev there after having induced the Czechs to invite a Russian technical team to the area. Bogomoltsev is spending a great deal of time at the NGB office in Aue in preparation for his trip.
- Beginning 1 November SAG Wismut was to have a monthly delivery schedule assigned by the Russians. There was to be a 74 percent increase in the material mined. 2. In view of the shortages in equipment, spare parts, transport, and skilled workers, these quotes are considered too high.
- Difficulties are reportedly being met with in persuading professional miners 3. to come to the SAG Wismut mines to work or stay on the job where they are.
