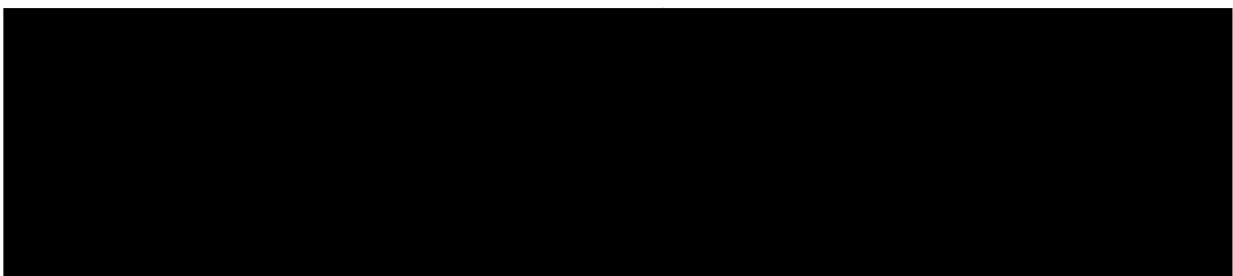

SOURCE

1. The Russians are much dissatisfied with the mining methods at Jachymov and are sending Prof. Bogomoltsev there after having induced the Czechs to invite a Russian technical team to the area. Bogomoltsev is spending a great deal of time at the MGB office in Aus in preparation for his trip.
2. Beginning 1 November SAG Wismut was to have a monthly delivery schedule assigned by the Russians. There was to be a 74 percent increase in the material mined. In view of the shortages in equipment, spare parts, transport, and skilled workers, these quotas are considered too high.
3. Difficulties are reportedly being met with in persuading professional miners to come to the SAG Wismut mines to work or stay on the job where they are.
