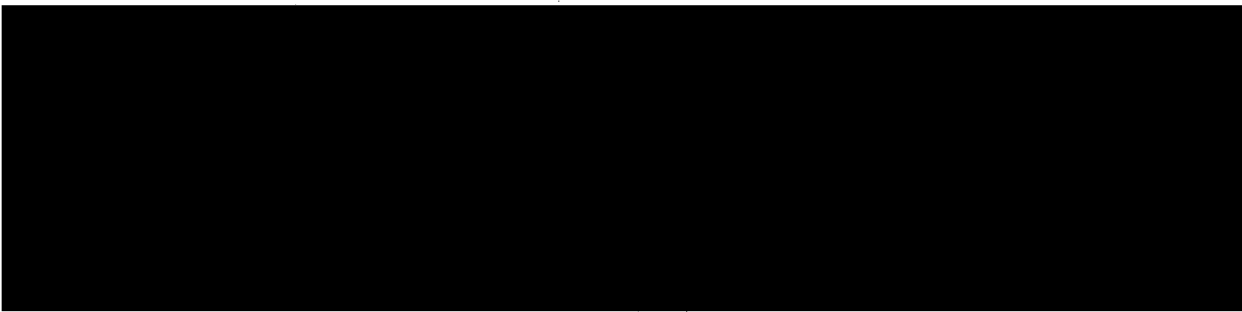

1. A strong movement, headed by Vittorio Zoppi, Secretary General of Foreign Affairs, is reportedly now underway to bring about the recall of Alberto Tarchiani, Italian Ambassador in Washington, and the latter's substitution by Pietro Quaroni, now Italian Ambassador in Paris.
2. The ground for criticism reportedly is Tarchiani's ineffectiveness.
3. According to source, the recall of Tarchiani, which will be fought bitterly within the Ministry, may take some time to effect.
