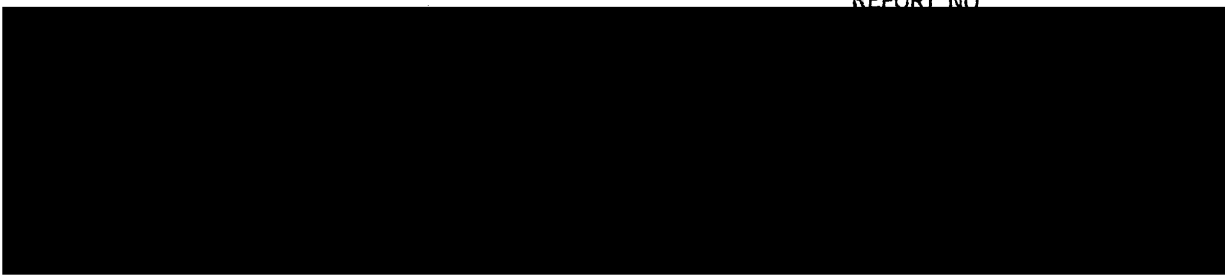

Each day three non-scheduled trains with eight to ten passenger cars travel along the Budapest-Belgrade railroad route. The trains stop only for fuel and water. Hungarian personnel are observed on these trains but none are permitted to leave the train at the stations; local police are present to see that the soldiers remain in the cars. The personnel of the railroad refer to these trains as "mute trains" because no talking is ever heard. The railroaders suspect the Hungarian soldiers are really Red Army men in Hungarian uniforms.
