SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.

- Many Javanese civil servants who formerly worked for the Dutch have been killed by the Communists. Over 500 wedanas, assistant wedanas, patihs, regents, and over 1,000 village chieftains and village policemen in the residencies of Kedoe. Jogjakarta, Soerakarta, Semarang, Rembang, Madiun, and Mediri have been kid-napped and murdered. These civil servants were considered well-qualified and indispensable by the Indonesian Republic.
- 2. The lightly-equipped rural and urban police could offer no match against wellarmed ex-Tentera Nasional Indonesia Communist troops.
- Remnants of the Indonesian Civil Service are found now only in Jogjakarta, Solo
