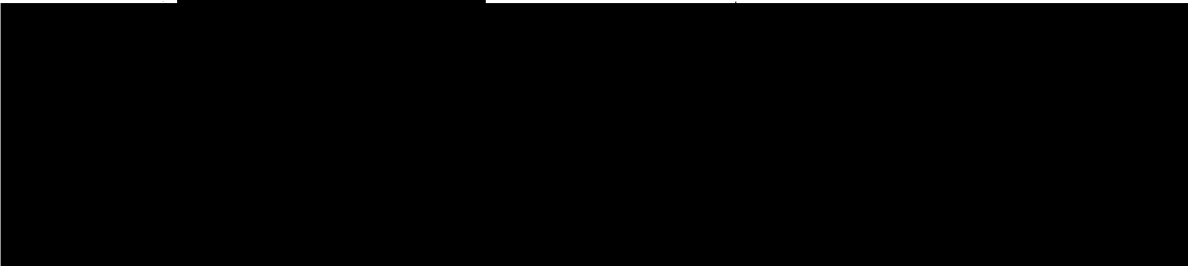

SOURCE

1. The following officers in the Yugoslav Army are reportedly either under surveillance or arrest:
 - a. Major General Danilo Trampuz, now released, but still under surveillance in Ljubljana.
 - b. Major General Sredoje Urosevic, Commander 2 Proletarian Division is still under detention in Belgrade.
 - c. Lieutenant Colonel Srgiyo Petrov, UDB chief for the Nis area.
 - d. Major Riki Nikolic, expelled from the Communist Party and the Army.
2. The Cominform is spreading the rumor inside Yugoslavia that Sreten Zujevic and Andrija Hebrang have been executed.
3. Four hundred and seventy alleged students sympathetic to the Cominform were expelled from Belgrade University. The entire Communist Party cell was also expelled from the medical faculty as well as the majority of the Communist Party members of the law faculty, including Bosa Kovacevic.
