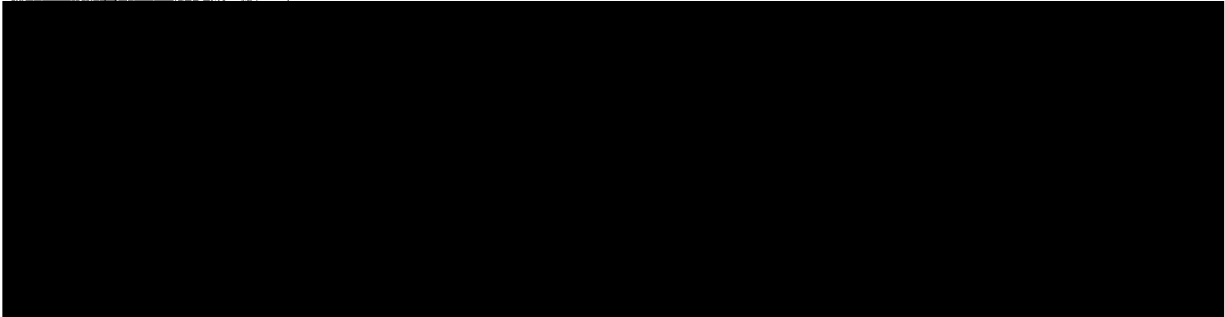

1. Although no official announcement has been made by the Argentine Government, Orlando Maroglio will be removed from the presidency of the Central Bank in Buenos Aires. Miguel Miranda, who reportedly submitted his resignation as President of the National Economic Council, has emerged the winner in his long feud with Maroglio (cf. [redacted]). Another government post may be offered to Maroglio.

2. Control of the government trading agency, IAPI, desired by both men, will fall indirectly to Miranda, although Ramon Cereijo, Minister of Finance, will be named chief.

3. Maroglio's ousting has been [redacted] several casual observers.
