1. Persistent rumors are going the rounds that Samaoen and Darsono, leaders of the 1926 Communist revolution and comrades of Tan Malaka, are to return to Java from Moscow.

2. These rumors are the result of difficulties encountered by the present Communist Government of Indonesia.
