- 1. It is reported that by the end of September 1948, the Yugoslavs were again sending arms, supplies and ammunition to the Greek Rebels in the Beles
- 2. The Rebel Army officer "Alekos" recently arrived at the Rebel liaison office at Donceli, Yugoslavia with three truck loads of arms and ammunition which had been brought from Veles to Djevdjelija by rail. This material, most of it said to have been of German origin, consisted of light machine guns, rifles, mines, bazookas and ammunition. It was subsequently sent over the Greek frontier by mule train via the Korona Mountains.
- Other unspecified supplies have been sent into the Beles Mountains via Gabrovo.
