1. Counterfeit Netherlands Indies Civil Administration (NICA) florin 100 banknotes, which are believed to be printed in Singapore, have been discovered in Batavia. Examples of false notes which have been discovered are numbers H. P. 00471 and H. P. 32835. The Second and Third Sections of the City Police are handling the case.
2. Oewang Repoebliek Indonesia (ORI) notes have also been counterfeited in a similar manner. They are believed to be made in Singapore and smuggled by airplane to Palembang, Batavia, Bandoeng, Semarang and Soerabaya.
