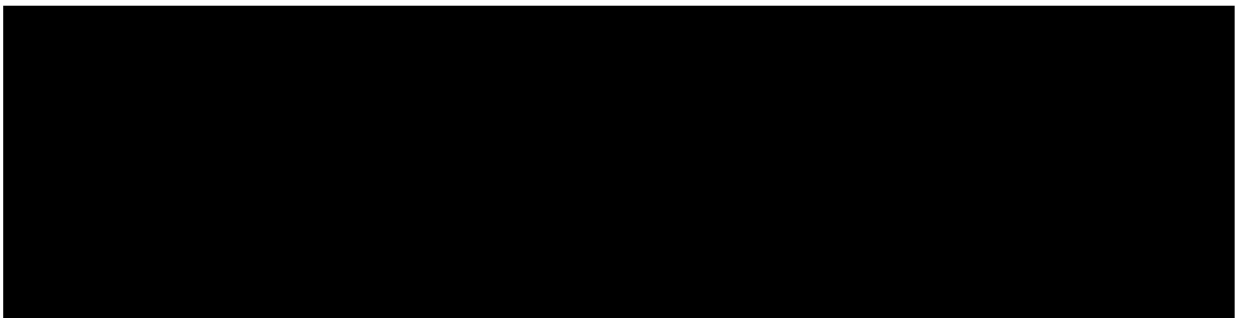

- Soetan Sjahrir's moderate socialist adherents in Batavia state that the Sentral Organisasi Boeroeh Seloeroeh Indonesia (SOBSI) is now in the process of reorganization. The new Secretariat is reported to be:

- 1st General Secretary Soeprapto, Master of Laws (LLM), who was deputy-chairman of Tan Malaka's Partai Komunis Indonesia (PKI) under Mohammed Joeseph, (LLM), until 2 July 1946; was held for the attempted coup d'etat on that date and released from jail in July 1948.
- 2nd General Secretary Patti Siregar, a Batak Communist, formerly interned at Boven Digoel.
- Financial Secretary Soeparno (a Javanese Communist).
- Secretary for Organization Koebarti Terenglimsoekitro (Javanese Communist).
- Secretary for Propaganda Bakri Siregar, a younger brother of Patti Siregar.
- Assistant Secretary for Propaganda Sardi.
- Secretary for Social & Economic Affairs Soeparjan (Javanese Communist).
- Contact Bureau Headed by Soeprapto; assistants - Moenadjib, Koebati and Soedarsono.

- The headquarters of the Secretariat is at Jogjakarta.
- The present reorganization of SOBSI was made necessary because many of the old leaders were eliminated as a result of the Madioen rebellion.
