

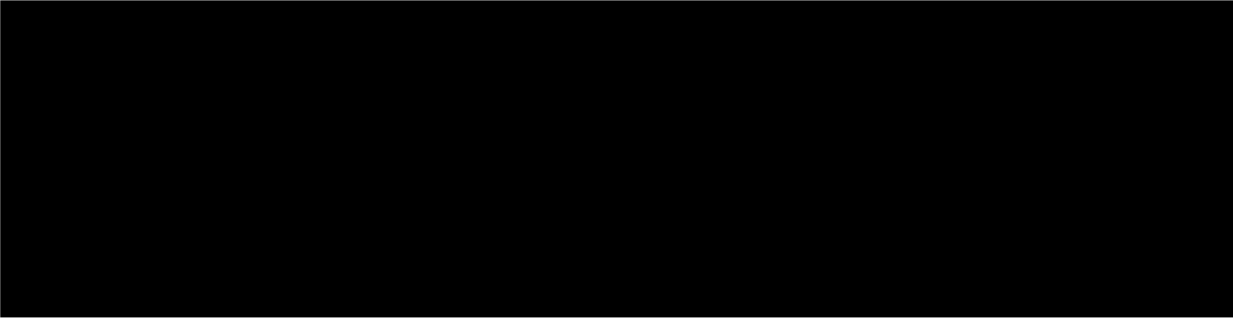

The Communist organization, Min Sheng Sze, Manggabesar No. 79, Batavia, is still tolerated by the Dutch Provisional Government on the strength of advice from ANG Tjin Thay, adviser for Chinese affairs to the Dutch Resident Commissioner, Zwager, and THIO Thiam Tjong, adviser for Chinese affairs to the Lieutenant Governor General (also head of the Persatoean Tionghoa (Chinese Federalist Union), Batavia). The Min Sheng Sze has decided to post a commissioner in every Chinese quarter throughout Java. [REDACTED] Comment. [REDACTED] reported Min Sheng Sze as a local central Chinese Communist body in disguise supported by Life Press, Batavia, which publishes the Communist daily and fortnightly, Sheng Huo Pao. Min Sheng Sze has enlisted and trained secretly about one thousand Chinese middle school children who are members of the Chinese Communist Youth Corps.)

2. YU You-Boon, managing director of the Liang Yu Book Company and adviser to the central council of the Min Sheng Sze, keeps a watch on Chinese "patriots" and members of the Kuomintang for the purpose of terrorizing them and kidnapping them on their return to China. [REDACTED] Comment. [REDACTED] reported that YU supplies books for the children trained by the Min Sheng Sze. This [REDACTED] him as a bookseller of the Kiang You Book Company; however, further information indicates that LIANG YU is the correct spelling.)

3. YO Fie Ching, disguised as a merchant trading under the name of TA Chung in the Gondangdia market, is a local Communist leader.

4. CHANG Ming An, a teacher in the Chinese high school at Pantjoran, Java, disseminates Communist propaganda to the students together with LOA Chan Hui, a graduate of an American university who specialized in economics. [REDACTED] Comment. A [REDACTED] CHANG Ming An as office manager for the Chinese newspaper, Sin Po, who had close contacts with Tass representative, George Afrin, when he was in Java, as well as having other Soviet connections.)

5. TJONG Joe Kioen, sub-editor of the Chinese daily, Seng Huo Pao, acts as an espionage agent in Manggabesar (Prinsenlaan) where Min Sheng Sze has its

headquarters. [redacted] Comment. [redacted] reported Seng Huo Pao as a special Communist daily in Batavia, still tolerated by the Dutch, and published by Life Press. WANG Koei-tjoe and ONG Kie-njan were listed as managing director and editor respectively, with TJONG Joe Kioen as sub-editor.)

- 6. The Ta Tsung Seng Huo Sze at Kerkstraat, Meester Cornelis, acts as center of Chinese Communist activities. Two important members of this organization are HIOE Fat Sioe and TJONG Fa Koen, rice merchants.
- 7. Active Communists in the local-born Chinese community are LIE Kian Kim, Chairman of the Sin Ming Lao Kung Hui (SMKH), and Dr. KHO Tjok King, Pintoe Besi No. 25, Batavia Centrum, whose job it is to coordinate all Communist activities in this area. To accomplish this KHO must maintain contact with LAUW King Hoo, commissary of Mohammed Joesoef's Partai Komunis Indonesia (PKI), SIAUW Giok Tjhan of the PKI, and Tony Wen, commandant of the International Brigade of Solo, through Tamzil and Raden A. Asmaoen.

[redacted] Comment. [redacted] reported LIE Kian Kim as keeping contact with Moeswalladi, Chairman of the reorganized branch of Sarekat Oemoem Boeroeh Seleroeh Indonesia (SOBSI). KHO Tjok King is listed in [redacted] as remaining with Sjahrir when the Partai Sosialis Indonesia (PSI) split and Sjahrir formed the new PSI. [redacted] LAUW King Ho as a leader of Chinese Communists in East Java, especially Malang.)
