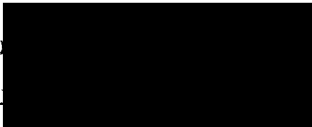

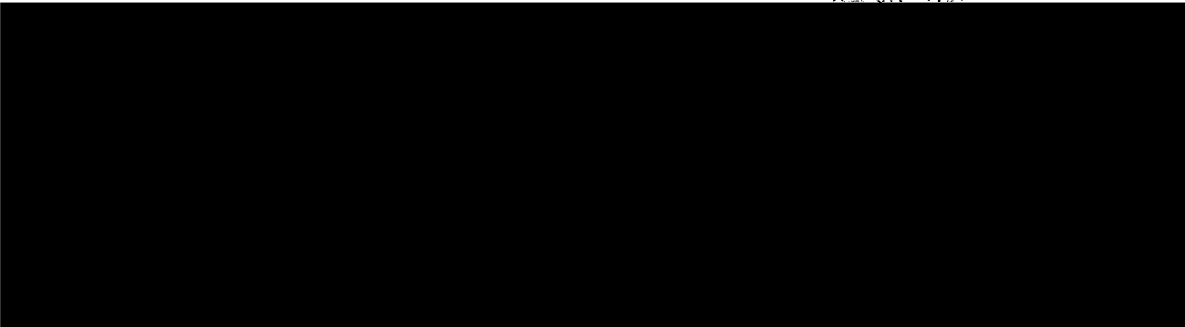

1. Rafael Angel Calderon Guardia, ex-President of Costa Rica, and his brother Francisco arrived in San Salvador from Nicaragua on 5 December and returned to Managua on 7 December.
2. The reported purpose of their trip was to recruit Costa Rican emigres and Salvadoran military men for a move against Figueres. Their mission was believed to be unsuccessful.
