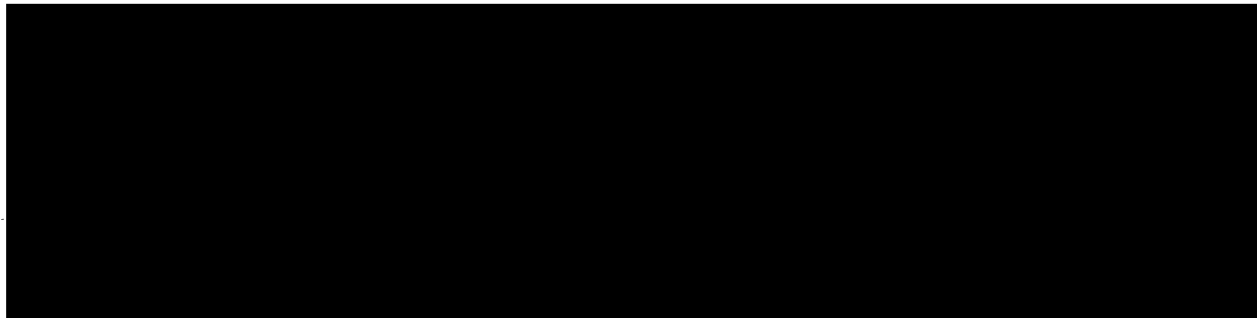

[REDACTED] Comment. It was reported on 26 December 1947 that A. Martabone was a member of the Good Will Mission from East Indonesia to the Republic of Indonesia and was a member of the Progressive faction.)

3. The right wing group supporting the Cabinet is composed of the following faction and leaders:

Federalists: Anak Agoeng Gde Agoeng, of Bali, with Dr. Soumoukil as the most reactionary member of his cabinet.

4. A. C. Manoppo and A. Martabone are making preparations for the formation of a new State of North Celebes, which is to be made up of Boeol, Gorontalo, and Bolaang Mongondow, with Manado as the center of government.

5. Johannes Latuharhary, East Indonesian nationalist leader appointed by the Republic of Indonesia as "Governor of Greater East", is now in Jogjakarta and is taking charge of the following armed political bodies:

- Gerakan Rakjat Indonesia Soenda Ketjil (GRISA) (Minor Soenda Indonesian People's Movement), commanded by A. S. Pello;
- Kebaktihan Rakjat Indonesia Soelawesi (KRIS) (Celebes Indonesian People's Loyalty), commanded by Kindangan;
- Ikatan Perdjuangan Kalimantan (IPK) (Borneo's Fighters' Association), commanded by G. M. Ibrahim of Bandjarmasin;
- Pemoeda Indonesia Maloekoe (PLM) (Moluccas Indonesian Youths' Party), consisting of pro-Republic Ambonese extremists.

Contact is to be kept in Batavia with Ali Boediardjo, member of Sjahrir's Partai Sosialis Indonesia (PSI) and of the Indonesian delegation. Boediardjo makes contact with A. Mononutu, Progressive leader at Makassar, through PIM's local commissary, E. R. Sumampouw, who was, in 1946, special area Indonesian civil police inspector, now living at Oud Gondangdia No. 26, Batavia Centrum. Dr. J. Ratoelangi, another important East Indonesian nationalist leader, is persona non grata with the Dutch (B-2).
