SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.

Ricardo Orue Reyes, a delegate of the Nicaraguan Liberal Independent Party, now in Guatemala City, told a friend on 3 December that all collaboration with the Nicaraguan revolutionists in Guatemala had been ended, and that he had received top level advice to return to Nicaragua. Orue confirmed that he had written to the Directive Body of the Liberal Independent Party for definite instructions, but would probably go back to Nicaragua.
