1. The Ikarus aircraft factory produces the following type aircraft:
 - a. Type 212 Monoplane-fighter. Fifty such aircraft have been delivered to the Yugoslav Air Forces.
 - b. Type 213 Same as type 212, except of wood construction, covered with linen. Only two test planes have been manufactured, although both types have been "accepted" for mass production.
 - c. Type 244 Bimotor light bomber. Two test planes are being finished at present. This plane will have the same armament as the Stormovik.
 - d. Type 214 Test planes are being finished. Types 244 and 214 should be in production in 1948.
 - e. Type 215 Production to start in 1948.
2. Ikarus has begun work on two improved Soviet planes, of the Stormovik type. It is a light fast bimotor bomber with a double tail and single wings. There are four machine guns -- one in each wing, one in front and one in the fuselage blister. Except for the guns in the fuselage, the guns are synchronized. The speed is 360 km per hour.
3. The motors for types 212 and 213 were acquired in Czechoslovakia. The newer types use French motors of 560 h.p.
