The Chinese Communists are relying for munitions supply on the following plants: a. A small plant in Tsinan (117-00,36-41) which is capable of producing

small arms ammunition in limited quantities. The Communists had this plant in operation immediately after they captured Tsinan (24 September 1948).

b. The munitions plant at Mukden. This plant, though capable of producing artillary shells. was not destroyed by the Nationalists.

2. Taiyuan (112-35,37-58) which is expected to fall to the Communists soon -- has a modern plant that can produce artillery shells, though casings must be brought in.
