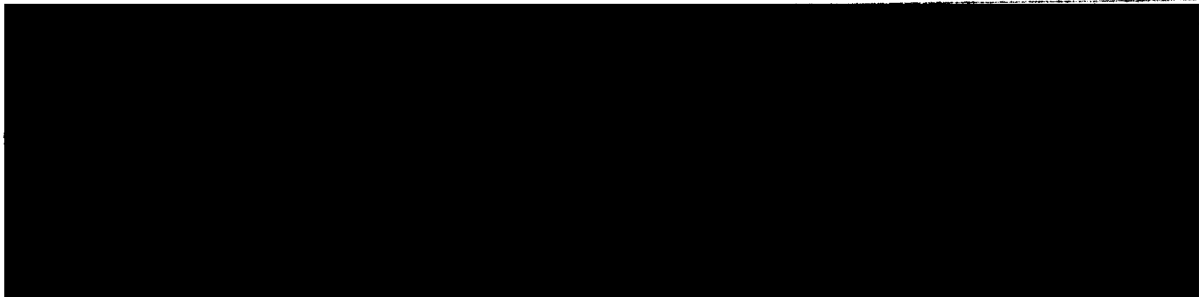

1. Passports belonging to Francisco Calderon Guardia, brother of Rafael Angel Calderon Guardia, and Alfredo Soto, another revolutionist, were confiscated by the Salvadoran Foreign Office. The two men tried to depart by air and by road, but were turned back.
2. By order of Salvadoran President Castaneda, no Costa Ricans were being allowed to leave San Salvador for Managua.
