- 1. The Franco Government, which formerly allotted to Carlos VIII and his propagandists a monthly stipend of 30,000 pesetas, discontinued this allowance after FRANCO'S interview with Don Juan.
- 25X1X 2. The Carlist propagandists, finding themselves without funds, wrote to Don Juan about mid-November 1948 offering him their services in return for a monthly remittance. [redacted], the Pretender was amused by this offer.
- 25X1X 3. The [redacted] Conde de Rodezno as authority for the statement that Carlos VIII himself has never claimed the Spanish throne, having simply been used by the Franquists as a threat to Don Juan.
