 - Strasburg (Uckermark) (U 96) - Neubrandenburg (U 66)
 - Grossschönebeck (Z 89) - Ruhlsdorf (Z 98)
- The following lines were out of action in Land Brandenburg in July 48:
 - Brandenburg (Altstadt) (Z 23) - Brielow (Z 23)
 - Ziehow (Q 22) - Schönermark (Kreis Angermünde) (Q 21)
 - Bad Freienwalde (Oder) (V 28) - Hohenwutzen (V 29)
 - Dolgelin (V 55) - Wollup (V 57)
 - Petersdorf (V 23) - Silberberg-Waldschänke (V 13)
- Traffic on the following lines, in Land Brandenburg was interrupted in July 48:
 - Hohenofen - Neustadt (Dosse) (Z 19) just before Neustadt
 - Beoskow (V 41) - Läßben (A 28) at Hartmannsdorf (A 29) and Briescht (V30)
 - Jüterbog (E 69) - Bürgermühle (E 69)
 - Luckenwalde (Z 70) - Jänickendorf (V 24)
- In accordance with an order from the SMA Saxony dated 29 June 48 at Dresden the second track of the Leipzig - Dresden line is being relaid forthwith. Work started at both ends on 8 July 1948. 2,000 German workmen and 400 Russian engineer troops from Königsbrunn were employed.
