1. General Nicolae Radescu's first attempt to form a "Military Council" that would adhere to his "Democratic Union of Free Rumanians" has met with failure. The idea of a "Military Council" was given up following the receipt by General Radescu of a letter from Colonel Ioanovici, Colonel Tomoroveanu, Colonel Neferu, and Commander Arpad Gherghel, leaders of the Rumanian career officers in Paris, in which the General was informed that career officers could not join a political group.
2. The following officers have joined General Radescu's "Union": Lieutenant Colonel Atanasiu, former Assistant Military Attache to Vichy; Major Maftai, a leader of the Iron Guard in Austria; and Captain Gheorghe Ilescu, Assistant Military Attache in London in 1940.
