1. It is planned that the production of crude aluminum will be resumed in the former IG Farben plant at Aken an der Elbe (D 96).
2. There are 83,000 tons of bauxite now stored at the dismantled Lautawerk, which will be allocated for this production. It is hoped that large quantities of bauxite can be imported from Hungary. Small amounts of bauxite have been arriving from Hungary recently, but have been allocated to the Zschornowitz plant to ensure the production of corundum-grinding discs.
