The Movimiento Socialista Revolucionaria (MSR), as well as its chief representative, Rolando Masferrer, has established friendly relations with President Carlos Prío Socarras of Cuba and with General Genevevo Perez Damera, Cuban Army Chief of Staff. According to source, such a relationship should strengthen the activities of the organization and should provide funds for the groups and its semi-official publication, Tiempo en Cuba. [REDACTED] Comment. The MSR in the past, through Tiempo en Cuba, has attacked Perez Damera, who has retaliated by having members of the MSR arrested even when there was no provocation. Evidence of the change in General Perez Damera's attitude is the fact that he is now supplying soldiers to act as bodyguards for Masferrer.)
