On 13 December 1948 four Costa Ricans in military garb, rank unknown, who arrived in two DC-3 planes at a commercial airfield Rancho Boyeros, in Habana, Cuba, were received by Cuban military and civilian personnel. The Costa Ricans and planes departed shortly thereafter for Batista Field, the Cuban Army Air Base at San Antonio de Los Baños. ~~Comment.~~ Comment. According to source, landing of the planes at Rancho Boyerso was in error. Arms for use against Costa Rican rebels reportedly are located at the Batista Field.)
