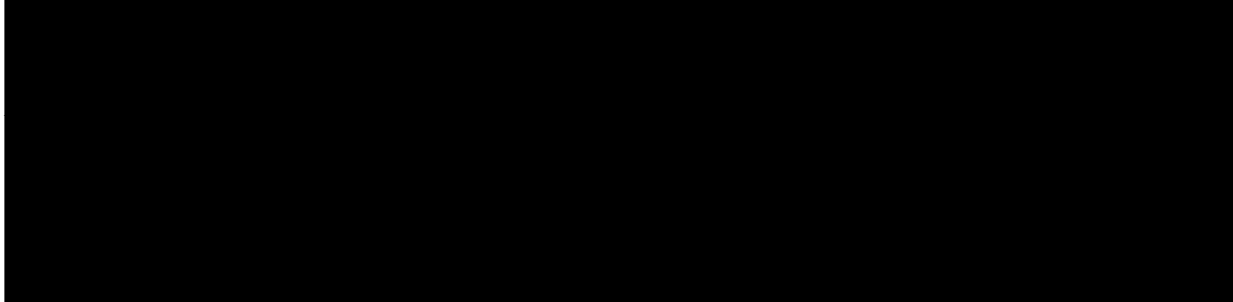

1. A serious rift in the Salvadorean junta is suspected because of its denial of aid to Nicaraguan revolutionaries only a day after it had promised them arms, funds, transit permission, and a base of operations. Reports of dissension were confirmed by the foster father of Maj. Oscar Osorio, one of the leaders of the junta, who stated that he feared for Osorio's life. Osorio is said to disagree with Lt. Col. Manuel de Jesus Cordoba, although not yet ready to support a plan to force him out of the junta.
2. Juan Jose Meza will return at once from Guatemala to El Salvador to renew efforts to get aid from the junta.
