This official hopes to diminish the loss of lives and destruction of property by appointing Indonesian police throughout Republican areas. He stated that the economy of the country had already been set back six months. He does not believe that Sukarno will be acceptable to the Indonesian Federalists .2. or to the Dutch. He believes that Hatta, Sjahrir and other former Republican officials will be offered posts in the new state of Central Java. It is unlikely that they will accept such posts as the Masjumi and the Partai Masional Indonesia groups have joined with the Communists in a common front of resistance. The Sultan of Jogjakarta has refused to talk with Hamid II, Sultan of Pontianak, except through former Republican leaders. 25X1X6 states that Indonesian Federalists are trying to attract some former Republican leaders from the new state of Central Java, but so far they have not been successful.
