- When the state of siege expired on 20 January 1949 in Bolivia, some 430 imprisoned and deported members of the Movimiento Nacionalista Revolucionario (MNR) started returning to civil life. Exiles such as Victor Paz Estenssoro, however, were not allowed to return, since they are considered as fugitives from justice for acts committed under the Villarroel regime.
- 2. No new state of siege is contemplated by the government unless the MIR creates some serious civil disturbance, and it is not believed that such disturbance is planned at present.
