- The Communist Party of Argentina (CPA) is currently undergoing a limited reorganization which was notivated by the following factors:
 - a. It was discovered by the Party that some of its members had supported the Peronista movement during the elections of 5 December 1948, and that some of them appeared to be actually affiliated with the Peronista movement;
 - b. The dissident Communist group which is headed by Aurelio Bracco and Redolfo Puiggros, the Novimiento Pro Congreso Extraordinario del Partido Comunista, advised its new members to remain in the ranks of the CPA, but to follow the instructions of the dissident group.
- The CFA leaders decided that to counteract the effects of the two cases cited above it would be necessary to institute a purge. However, it is not intended that the purge will be addespread nor that it will be made public. The party will proceed cautiously in removing from their places of responsibility the andividuals who have been influenced by the Peronista Party or the dissident autigros-Bracco group. Such individuals will not be excelled from the CPA as a rule, but they will be relegated to positions where they will be able to do only a minimum of harm to the party.
- The Central Committee has ordered that all <u>carmets</u> be submitted for renewal. This is a customary annual process, but on this occasion it will provide a means to check on the reliability and conduct of all members. It is not known just how the committee plans to investigate each individual.
- in the CPA is expected to iterease its anti-imperialist propaganda during 1949 as one of its major long-rage projects. The first project of importance for the current year, which is a ready underway, is to have all cells and groups diffuse propaganda in support of the forthcoming Congress for Peace and Democracy which has to be held in Mexico Mity. The party has also ordered its members to propagandize the congress in local unions in an attempt to gain the support of the Coufederacion General del Trabajo (CCT).
