SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.

1. On 9 December 1948 an official of the Netherlands-USSR Society, who is also a Communist Party member, discussed the future policy of the Society with F. S. Gusev, Secretary of the Soviet Embassy.
2. At this meeting Gusev announced that WOKS, a section of the USSR Embassy supporting propaganda and cultural activities, would increase the monthly subsidy of the Society from fl. 3,000 to fl. 4,000. Gusev further stated that, if the Society would rent a building in Amsterdam containing space suitable for a film projection room, a large room for exhibitions, and office space, the Soviet Embassy would bear the costs.
