25X1A6a It has been learned that at least three days prior to the 30 January 1949 coup d'etat in Paraguay, Felipe Molas Lopez and Liberato Rodriguez had succeeded in lining up against the Gonzalez government the group which had rebelled against the Gonzalez government on 25 October 1948 ( [REDACTED] Comment. Colonel Carlos Montanaro, Colonel Alfredo Stroessner, and the Military School), as well as most of the officials of the Cavalry Division. With this support, the Molas Lopez group believed they would dominate the situation in a short time by means of a military revolt.
